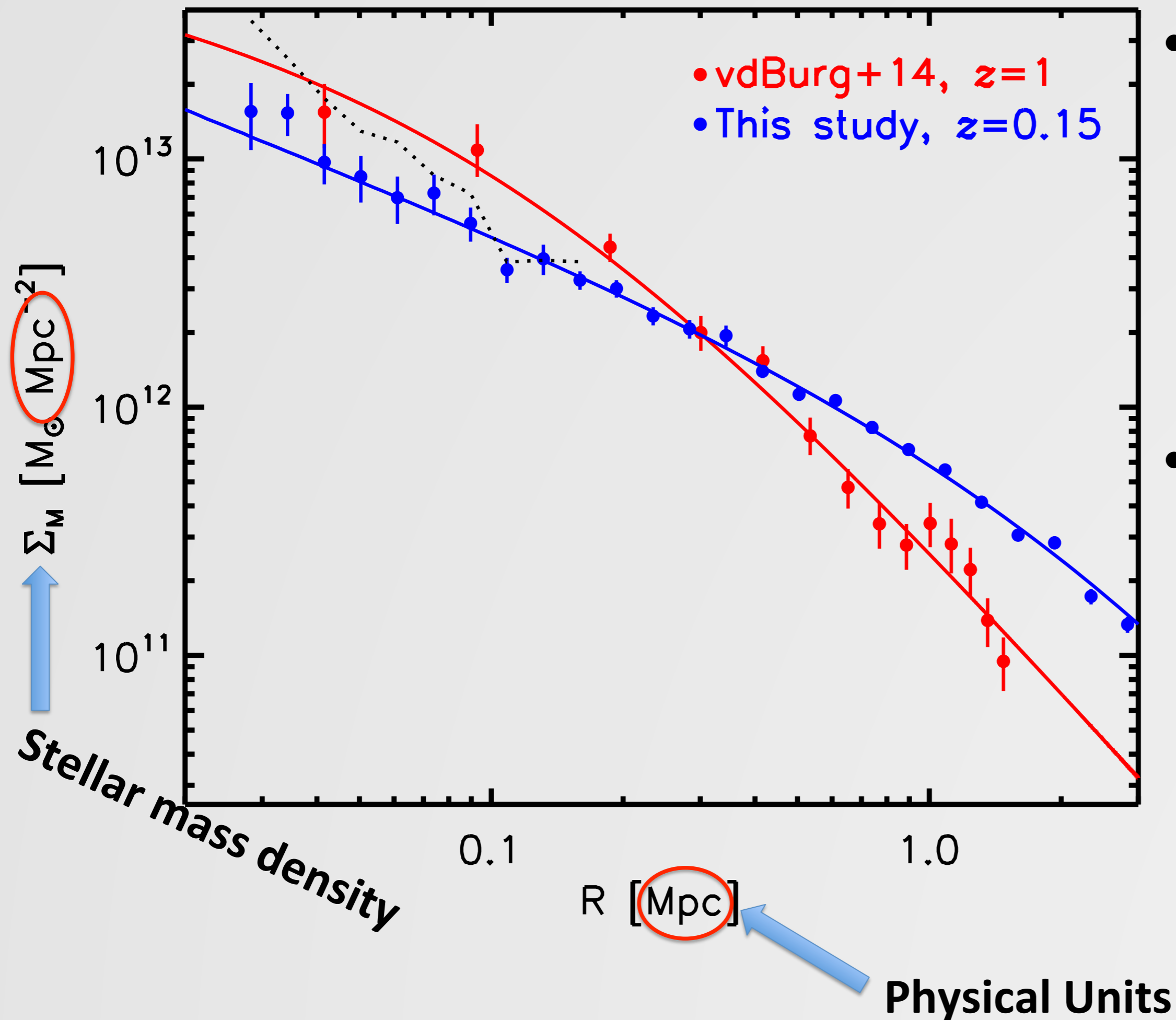


The distribution of stellar mass in galaxy clusters: Galaxy clusters **growing inside-out** since $z \approx 1$

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- The central part ($R < 0.2$ Mpc) of the stellar mass distribution in local galaxy clusters is already in place at $z \approx 1$.
- Since then, clusters assemble their stellar mass primarily onto the outskirts

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
